Union Shops - Dues for union shops, signatory to Local 1926, are \$50.00 per year, plus the one time \$100.00 affiliation fee. This is because Union shops pay a per-man-hour-worked contribution to the Hawaii Flooring Industry Improvement Fund which forwards the dues amount to HFA.

LEGISLATIVE

DEFEATED: An attempt to not require a contractor's license to install carpet and to raise the current \$1000 exemption to \$100,000.

DEFEATED: A requirement to warn people about supposed "health hazards" from new carpet and to require that hemp carpeting be given a preference for all state and county jobs.

SUPPORTED: Proposal to lower the 4% excise tax for sales representatives to 1/2%.
